We don't have a vaccine for colon cancer. We don't have a vaccine for breast cancer. But there is a vaccine for cervical, mouth and throat cancers.

We encourage all children to be vaccinated against HPV regardless of sex.

The HPV vaccine is the only vaccine that prevents cancer.

It is important for all children, both male and female, between the ages of 9-12 years old to receive the two shot vaccine series before their 13th birthday.
