Starting at age 9-10, you can start to protect your pre-teens from serious diseases like HPV cancers, Meningitis, Tetanus, Whooping Cough, Flu and COVID-19 with timely vaccinations

RECOMMENDED VACCINATIONS

AGE 9 - 10

- ☐ **HPV dose 1** (Human Papillomavirus)
- ☐ **HPV dose 2** (6-12 months after dose 1)

AGE 11 - 12

- ☐ **Meningitis dose 1** (MenACWY)
- ☐ **Tdap** (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
- ☐ **HPV** (if 2 doses haven't been given)

AGE 16

- ☐ **Meningitis dose 2** (MenACWY)
- ☐ **Meningitis B** series (MenB)

☐ **Flu** (seasonal Influenza)
